As we approach the Season of Lent, you are invited to join Good Shepherd friends in pursuing worship and devotional opportunities to deepen our faith. You can worship from home or come to the sanctuary for some of these special events.

We are also offering a daily devotional for Lent. Pick up a copy in the narthex of our sanctuary. A congregational member will be sharing one of these devotions every week on our church Facebook page, so check there to view these short expressions of faith.

Here are some highlights in the area of worship, fellowship, and the practice of prayer during Holy Week.

Eggtravaganza! Bring in already-filled plastic eggs and drop them in the basket in the narthex or bring in wrapped candy and plastic eggs for filling during the month of March. Good Shepherd is pairing with the Lions Club this year, and we expect many children and parents to join us. Be sure the eggs you donate are large enough to allow a piece of candy to be inside.

Sunday, March 19: Easter flower orders are due today. Use the form to order; cost is \$10 per flower.

Thursday, March 23: Gather to fill eggs and make a count of all that has been collected. We meet at 10:00 a.m. to fills eggs and share fellowship.

Sunday, March 26: The choir presents special music on the theme of "Amazing Love." The worship service will contain wonderful music and meaningful readings.

Saturday, April 1: Good Shepherd pairs with the Joppatowne Lions Club for our annual Easter Egg Hunt. Children will meet in the sanctuary for an opening welcome and be dismissed by age group to the "Hunt." Snacks on the lawn, "Take and Make" crafts bags, and small prize bags will be distributed to all who attend. In case of rain, we will postpone until the following Saturday, April 8 at 11:00 a.m.

Sunday, April 2: Arrive five minutes early, select your seat in the sanctuary, and then meet in the hallway. We will have palms for all and join in an opening Call to Worship and process in singing a Hosanna Hymn. The praise and passion of this special Palm Sunday starts off Holy Week at Good Shepherd.

Wednesday, April 5: As part of the Susquehanna Parish Mid-Week Lenten Service Series, Good Shepherd hosts a service in the sanctuary at 7:00 p.m. You can view the service from home, too. We will worship with a Scripture Echo centering on Jesus washing his disciple's feet.

Thursday, April 6: The Night of Remembrance, Betrayal, and Arrest....A short worship service in the sanctuary observing Holy Communion, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

Friday, April 7: Visit our sanctuary any time between noon and 3:00 p.m. A prayer handout will be available with special music playing and a "Way of the Cross" video to enhance the Good Friday Vigil. Simply read silently your prayers and remember the Last Words of Christ and all that happened at his crucifixion. We trust we will have someone in the sanctuary all through the afternoon, praying and walking the way with Christ.

Sunday, April 9: Put a flower on the cross, a butterfly on our display, ring an Alleluia Bell, and celebrate the resurrection of Christ Our Lord! There will be no after-church fellowship today so that families may spend time together. Remember to take your Easer flowers at the conclusion of the worship service for enjoyment during the coming week.

We hope to see you at these events and wish you peace, calm, and assurance of faith during Lent and Holy Week. March 2023


