The month of March is the bulk of our journey toward the cross of Jesus.

Our faith tells us two major things about God. First, that God is eternal, all-powerful, and dwells in heaven, so far from us as to be unknowable and unassailable. Second, this God freely chooses to love us and to care for us, and to become available to us – to bridge the divide between the divine and the mortal. This approach by God comes in different ways. There were many such encounters between God and God's people recorded in the Bible as it recounts the history of the faith journey, but those are not the only times God comes near to us. In our daily lives, every time we pray, God bridges the gap to listen to our adoration, our confession, our thanksgiving, and our supplication. There are also special times and special circumstances when the divide between the finite and the infinite becomes amazingly thin. These are Christmas and Easter (the seasons we celebrate with white decorations). At Christmas the divine becomes the human, and at Easter that human is restored to the divine. You could say that the finite and the infinite actually cross! (OK, maybe that's a little TOO esoteric).

Lent, then, is our chance to prepare ourselves for this transcendent mix – to allow our spirits to be transported from our earthly existence into a divine reality that surrounds us all the time.

So, Friends, I wish you a powerful, meaningful, inspired and transcendent Lent.

May God watch over you each day and give you...
